Technical regulations and conditions:

The Synchronized Skating Cup 2022 will be held according to the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the Special Regulations and Technical Synchronized Skating 2018 as well as the valid Technical Rules and Conditions SYS of Swiss Ice Skating.

Important: The organiser advises the teams of the Non-ISU categories to refer to the special and adjusted Technical Conditions SYS (see **Swiss Technical Guidelines 2021/2022, issued 10nd June 2021**). All details are also found on the Swiss Ice Skating homepage.

Teams, which have participated in the ongoing season in a certain category, are not allowed to take part in another category at the Synchronized Skating Cup EVBN.

Judging system:

The ISU judging system will be used.

Music:

After final registration, the music must be uploaded online (oneDrive). The respective link will be submitted accordingly to all registered teams and will be supported by our system administrator. Although a digital replay is primarily striven, CDs are accepted upon request based on the ISU guideline. Teams are requested to bring their CDs as back-up, well marked with **name, club and programme, length of the music** as well as the **name of composers** (for SUIA – copy rights).

Dressing Rooms

Whenever possible a dressing rooms are allocated to the teams. With a lot of attendance, the rotation principle will apply. Schedules for the dressing rooms are listed on the detailed timetable. We kindly ask the teams to leave their dressing rooms immediately after practice and competition.

Attention: All teams must take their baggage with them. Baggage can't be left in the dressing rooms or at the ice rink!

Registration Office and Tickets

The registration office is located at the ice rink.

Tickets for the competition cost CHF 12.00 for adults and CHF 3.00 for children (6-15 years).

Tickets are also applicable for non-official escort and fans.

Warm-up area:

The warm-up area is located next to and linked to the ice rink in three gyms. The warm-up times follow a fixed distribution. The exact time schedules will be on the timetables following by e-mail.

It may happen that two teams must share one warm-up area. We kindly ask these teams to be respectful for each other. Each team must bring its own music equipment.

The official practice will take place on Saturday, 29th January 2022.

10 minutes: short programme Juniors ISU and Senior ISU

11 minutes: free programme Junior ISU and Junior B

10 minutes: free programme Basic Novice, Juveniles, Advanced Novice, Mixed Age, Adult

12 minutes: free programme Senior ISU and Seniors B

The official practice is mandatory.
